Of the 58 doctoral students who graduated from the program between 2010 and 2020, 44 (76%) have obtained licensure as psychologists and 7 (12%) are in the process of obtaining licensure. Some graduates are employed in settings not requiring licensure, and recent graduates are often in the process of completing supervised training.
