

- Leadership skills in family-centered, inclusive practices that focus on young children at risk due to poverty, linguistic or cultural differences, and developmental delays.
- Interdisciplinary perspective that prepares graduates to work collaboratively on teams with families and professionals from a variety of disciplines and agencies.
- Licensure in North Carolina Advanced/M-Level BK License (if already holding A-Level licensure).
