In this role I have valued teaching, and partnerships created across campus in the efforts to support the growth of students and NC State faculty. This year, I was fortunate to deliver the 2023 keynote for the NC Association for Institutional Effectiveness Research (NCAIR), which allowed me to reach a broad audience of researchers on the topic of building a culture of belonging. At NC State I have had opportunities to contribute to SACSCOC accreditation reports and site visits. I've been able to drive collaboration and partnerships across the state, which have led to an award-for the senior-level mentoring launched for our graduate students. I maintain student and executive mentor profiles representing over 50 institutions, 80+ students, and 30+ executive mentors. I've relied upon data science to impact recruitment efforts, increasing prospects by approximately 50%. I have provided service as a subject matter expert (SME) for content and teaching related to program planning, evaluation, instructional design, change management, organizational ethics, and leadership. I treasure generating partnerships that extend beyond the classroom. One instructional partnership involves partnering with a health science program providing a service-learning opportunity for graduate students who seek to build their evaluation

skills. I partner students in my course with this external partner to provide their annual evaluation through service learning. These evaluation efforts not only provide students with the opportunity to apply theory to practice, but also serves to inform the effectiveness of services and make recommendations for program improvements. In addition, I have become familiar with NC State's processes to partner with business and sales vendors to navigate efficient ways of expending resources. I value promoting internal activities to students, fellows, and faculty to promote their engagement and create awareness of resources. I also appreciate highlighting the achievements of students and colleagues, and often nominate deserving colleagues and students for consideration of awards and opportunities. I collaborate with team members on a variety of projects and promote best practices in teaching and learning. I develop and execute customized education curriculum with engaging training content aligned with learner needs for colleges external to NC State through the Belk Center. I generate data-driven reports and deliver presentations to executives, clients, and industry leaders. I design, plan, and deliver online, hybrid, hyflex and face-to-face (F2F) human-centered courses and have completed DEI certification and training (i.e., GLBT Ally, Green Zone Certified, inclusive teaching pedagogy). I lead design processes for innovative pathways, identifying lead experts to process and optimize solutions for exceeding quality standards, ultimately impacting retention and outcomes. I value the ability to develop and maintain strong relationships and partnerships with internal and external stakeholders, program directors, coordinators, fellows, and leaders. I understand the process and importance of identifying priorities, developing strategic plans, and creating a solid foundation for evaluation processes. I am competent at conducting research, analyzing data, & communicating findings. I am familiar with responsible budget management and the importance of following fiscal policies and operational procedures. As a Faculty Fellow with OFE, I've been able to lead the efforts of a university-wide faculty mentoring program, which has allowed engagement and connection with exceptional leaders across NC State's campus.

In this role I oversaw data collection and analysis to deliver and present reports to the institution's administrators and the Board of Trustees targeting specific objectives and goals related to the improvement of writing skills for students. I presented findings to senior level administration and external stakeholders, analyzed data and generated reports for SACSCOC accreditation processes. I established external relationships to generate and foster development of new programs. This position required expert management skills for multiple complex projects with competing timelines. I hired, onboarded, and provided supervision of multiple teams, faculty, and contracted employees. I also taught courses, designed hybrid curriculum, contributed to accreditation reviews and reports, and created an onboarding program and resource manual for part-time faculty. I was able to connect student success with completion and persistence data through thoughtful insights and storytelling features. I

managed daily operations, like course scheduling, monitoring enrollment, and identifying instructional needs, to ensure an efficient use of resources and provided continued leadership and guidance for the Crisis Intervention Team. I contributed to input on policy revisions. Through mediating conflict, I identified resolutions to common challenges, and generated plans for action and opportunity. I conducted succession planning to ensure the continued mission to provide services to those experiencing mental health crisis. I remained on contract to complete the QEP narrative after accepting my current role with NC State.

In this role I led efforts to write, secure, and lead a competitive federal grant program designed to serve diverse learners, securing approximately \$2.7M. Leadership efforts included, the delivery of program services, data collection, program planning, and evaluation. I collected and analyzed data to deliver and present federal reports targeting specific objectives and goals in a fast-paced, high stress environment while learning new systems and applications. I was part of the organization's Institutional Effectiveness committee where I contributed to accreditation reviews and reports, reviewed annual program plans to ensure alignment with objectives and the institution's strategic plan, and advised faculty on annual planning processes associated with SACSCOC requirements. I hired and onboarded team members and served as the Staff Association President. I shifted the culture of the program to a strengths-based climate, focusing on the success of students and employees, identifying opportunities to boost employee morale and recognize talent. I established external relationships to generate and foster development of new programs and launched a state-wide director's collaborative network where program directors could meet monthly to problem solve and share resources. I continued leadership of the CARE (Crisis Assessment, Response, and Evaluation) Team. I designed hybrid curriculum for workshops related to study skills, and first-generation student success. I hired, supervised, and managed a team of staff. I partnered with Veteran's Upward Bound, a program designed for adult learners who are military veterans to share resources and reduce burden on staff. I provided input for policies and procedures, wrote policy manuals, and managed federal and state budgets.

In this position I coordinated efforts to deliver services aligned with federal grant objectives serving a diverse population of adult learners. I collected data, conducted evaluations, and wrote and presented reports. Counseling services delivered to students included: workshop facilitation, group sessions, collaborative advising, and resource use guidance. I identified funding opportunities to support student access to housing, transportation, and childcare. The establishment of external relationships to generate and foster the development of new programs was critical to the success of the students and the program. I was able to establish a resource, The Elevation Market, to meet the needs of students facing food insecurities, which evolved to include clothing for students to have professional attire for job interviews. To mitigate challenges associated with mental health crisis, I created and led a program to spearhead policies and organizational efforts providing access to students and employees who experienced crisis through a CARE (Crisis Assessment, Response, and Evaluation) Team. I secured an external grant to support the launch and resources needed to sustain the CARE Team. I designed hybrid curriculum for workshops and contributed to accreditation reviews and reports.

This role allowed space for me to achieve and surpass placement goals for individuals seeking employment and career access. I served on an advisory board for community groups and was appointed to the governor's task force serving to meet labor market demands during a time of significant layoffs requiring reskilling access for the workforce. I provided service as liaison, spearheading communication efforts between clients, employers, evaluators, and medical providers. I examined medical records to identify needs and establish accommodations in the workplace. I made recommendations for accessibility in the workplace. This role required knowledge and expertise in federal and state policies, U.S. Department of Labor reports and trends, as well as knowledge of labor market research. I managed daily operations and provided supervision of casework assistant staff. I designed counseling for clients with a specific focus on solution-based strategies inclusive of resource access for individuals with disabilities who require accommodations.
